Uniform

We have two uniforms for the children to wear: Uniform A and Uniform B. Children are welcome to choose which one they would like to wear but items cannot be mixed between the two, e.g. grey socks must be worn with grey trousers/shorts.

All items are compulsory unless stated. The number of each sporting item is left for you to decide but do bear in mind they are needed for at least 4 days per week.

Sports Clothing & Equipment

The School does not provide games equipment unless specifically stipulated, although Cricket helmets and keepers' pads, Hockey goal-keepers' gear and 1st Team strips are provided. We recommend custom-fitted mouth guards for hockey & rugby and the mouth guard suppliers, OPRO, visit the School in the Michaelmas Term. A leaflet is sent out to all parents of children in Year 2 and above during the Trinity Term and this needs to be returned direct to OPRO (or done via their website) in advance. Alternatively, a temporary mouth guard may be purchased, and these are available from most sports shops/websites.

Naming of Clothing and Possessions

All clothing, (including home clothes for Boarders & Flexi-Boarders), pencil cases, school bags, sports bags and equipment, shoes, trainers and boots worn or used by children at school should be clearly marked with their initials and surnames, preferably with nametapes, or in some other indelible way.


Naming Guidelines

To be sewn in the following locations:




Blazers: Label to be sewn just above the inside pocket.

Ties: Label to be sewn the reverse of the tie, towards the thicker end.



Shirts and blouses
Dresses and coats
Jumpers and cardigans
Hoodies, coats, pyjama tops, T-shirts,
Pyjama tops
Bra/Cron tops and yests


Label to be sewn inside the collar at the back of the neck. Or the top of the centre back for those without collars.
(Including sports kit and home clothes)



Trousers and shorts
Skirts and skorts
Tracksuit bottoms and swimming kit
Pyjama bottoms and underwear

Label to be sewn inside the waistband and the centre back.




Socks
(Including sports socks and home socks)
Tights

For socks, label to be sewn along the bottom of the foot on the outside of the sock. Each sock must be named.

For tights, label to be sewn inside the waistband. It is recommended that the label be sewn vertically to allow more stretch.



Towels Bedding Flannels To be sewn along the short edge of the towel, pillowcase, or duvet cover, near the corner. Similarly, near a corner for flannels.



Gloves, Scarves, Hats

Inside the hat band, on the bottom edge of the scarf and inside the cuff of the gloves.
